From the Registrar

A great way to start the year off right is to get your registration form to me on

time! For the Spiritual Enrichment Brunch, I need your form postmarked by January 31st. So put this at the top of your UWFaith to-do list.

Here's the when and how to register for district events:

Put our event dates on your calendars and plan ahead. The registration forms for the Spiritual Enrichment Brunch and the Spiritual Growth Retreat can be found in our December newsletter, Around the Bay (which we will re-name). Forms can also be downloaded from our website

(https://www.umwmichiganconference.org/cbd.html).

The district team encourages local units to register as a unit. Of course, you can register individually, but why go alone? Bring a friend—it's more fun!

We do ask that you pre-pay for the events. As registrar, I help coordinate with the host unit and our Spiritual Growth coordinators on these two events. That's especially important when the host unit needs to purchase food based on attendance. If 10 women register without pre-paying and then don't show up the day of the event, we will be short of funds to cover our expenses. Keep in mind that our district events are NOT fundraisers. Our goal is to break even.

When you arrive with your unit, you will check in by your church name. Only one member of your unit needs to stop at the registration table to pick up your name tags and programs, which helps reduce congestion. Everyone else can hang up coats, find the restrooms, and grab a cup of coffee before the program begins.

I realize that life happens between the time you submit your registration form and the event. Unfortunately, we can't refund your payment. But you can invite someone else to take your place.
