

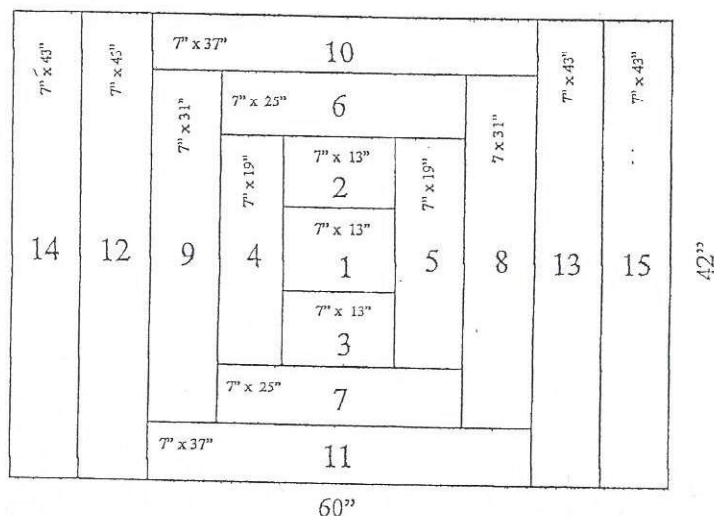
"Cover Them w/Love" Quilt

Use cotton, polycotton, or flannel. This is a reversible quilt—both sides done at the same time. We do not put batting in these quilts. Finished size is minimum of 42" x 60".

Start in the center and cut two strips 7" x 13". Put wrong sides together. The next piece (cut same size) goes on top and bottom of center piece with right sides together. Makes a sandwich with the center in between. Open out the pieces just sewn on. Do the same to the other side of the center piece. So now you have three pieces sewn together (front and back). Now build on the sides of these three pieces using numbers 4 & 5. Continue sewing the same as previously using number 6 & 7. Continue according to the diagram. It might be a good idea to serge or zigzag over seams as you go.

Seam size 1/2 inch.

Cutting directions: No. 1, 2, & 3-cut 6 pieces 7" x 13". No. 4 & 5-cut 4 pieces 7" x 19". No. 6 & 7-cut 4 pieces 7" x 25". No. 8 & 9-cut 4 pieces 7" x 31". No. 10 & 11-cut 4 pieces 7" x 37". No. 12, 13, 14, & 15 cut 8 pieces 7" x 43".



When you have it about 42" x 60" bind off the edges and you are done. Smaller sized quilts for babies are also acceptable. The quilt does not have to be this exact pattern as long as the quilt measures approximately 42" x 60" and is sewn together-not tied.

DIRECTIONS: Note: Sweater is knitted in one piece from neckline down.

Neckband: CO 67, 71, 77 sts. Working back and forth in rows:

RS: Knit 1 Row

WS: K1, (YO, K2Tog) across

RS: Knit 1 Row

WS: K5, Purl across to last 5 sts, K5

Establish Yoke Pattern:

Row 1: RS, Knit 12, 13, 15 sts [left front], YO,

K1 [seam st.] YO,

Knit 7, 7, 7 sts [left sleeve],

YO, K1 [seam St.] YO,

Knit 25, 27, 29 sts. [back],

YO, K1 [seam St.] YO,

Knit 7, 7, 7 sts [right sleeve].

YO, K1 [seam St.] YO,

Knit 12, 13, 15 sts [right front]

Row 2: WS, K5 sts, purl across all sts. including YOs to last 5 sts, K5

Row 3: RS, Knit 13, 14, 16 sts [left front], YO,

K1 [seam st.] YO,

Knit 9, 9, 9 sts [left sleeve],

YO, K1 [seam St.] YO,

Knit 27, 29, 31 sts. [back],

YO, K1 [seam st.] YO,

Knit 9, 9, 9 sts [right sleeve],

YO, K1 [seam st.] YO,

Knit 13, 14, 16 sts [right front]

Row 4: WS, K5 sts, purl across all sts. including YOs to last 5 sts, K5

Work in this fashion increasing one stitch on each front and two stitches on each of the sleeves and back until there are 163, 175, 189 sts on needle. There will be 13, 14, 15 YO holes down one side of each seam St (including the one hole in neckband). End finishing row an even numbered row.

Divide for Sleeves and Body:

Knit 25, 27, 30 sts [left front] and place on holders.

Knit 31, 33, 35 sts [left sleeve] and leave on needle

ABBREVIATIONS: BO = Bind Off, Beg = Beginning, CO = Cast On, Dec = Decrease, Inc = Increase, K = Knit, K2Tog = Knit 2 sts together, K3Tog = Knit 3 sts together, MC = Main Color, P = Purl, P2Tog = Purl 2sts together, Pat = Pattern; Rep = Repeat, Rnd(s) = Round(s), RS = Right Side, Sl = Slip, SSK = SL,SLK, St(s) = Stitch(es), StSt = Stockinet Stitch, W'S = Wrong side, YO = Yarn over

Place 51, 55, 59 sts [back] on holder

Place 31, 33, 35 sts [right sleeve] on holder

Place 25, 27, 30 sts [right front] on holder.

Left Sleeve: Working on left sleeve stitches only, CO 3, 4, 5 sts and purl 1 row. Work even 6 rows StSt. Dec. 1 st both sides on next and every 6th row until 24, 29, 30 sts remain. Work even until sleeve measures 4½, 5½, 7½ inches from underarm CO, ending on RS row.

Cuff.-

WS: Knit 1 Row

RS: K1, (YO, K2Tog) across

WS: Knit 1 Row

RS: BO all sts in Knit.

Right Sleeve: With RS facing return 31, 33, 35 sts of right sleeve to needle. Join yam in first St and CO 3, 4, 5 sts. Knit across all 34, 37, 40 sts ending at front edge of sweater. Work 7 rows of St st. Dec 1 St on both sides on next and every 6th row until 24, 29, 30 sts remain ending on RS row. Complete as for left sleeve.

Body: With RS facing, place without working 25, 27, 30 sts of Left Front onto right hand needle.

-Pick up and knit 3, 4, 5 sts from underarm of Left Sleeve;

-Place 51, 55, 59 sts of Back onto left hand needle and knit across these sts.

-Pick up and knit 3, 4, 5 sts from underarm of Right Sleeve;

-Place 25, 27, 30 sts of Right Front onto left hand needle and knit across these sts. There are 107, 117, 129 sts on needle.

Next row: WS, K5 Purl across to last 5 sts, K5. Keeping the 5 edge sts in garter st and all remaining stitches in stockinet work until body measures 4½, 5½, 7½" inches from underarm finishing RS row.

Hem: Work as for cuff on sleeves.

Finishing: Sew underarm seams. Weave in all loose ends. Thread ribbon through eyelet rows on collar and cuffs and tie bows.

END

yarn, fasten off pink.

Next row: K 1, *yo, k 2 tog.* across, ending k 1.

Purl 1 row.

Raglan rows: Change to No. 10 needles.

Row 1: K 9, (yo, k 1, yo) (this will now be called "seam" throughout and will form the raglan increases), k 3, (seam) k 10, (seam) k 3, (seam) k 9.

Row 2: (And all even rows) k 4, purl to last 4 st, k 4.

Row 3: K 10, (seam) k 5, (seam) k 12, (seam) k 5, (seam) k 10.

Row 4: Same as row 2. Continue making the last 2 rows, making (seam) over the seam in same manner on knit rows until there are 110 stitches on the needle, ending with a purl row.

Dividing row: K 18 sts, take off next 23 sts on holder (1st sleeve) cast on 2 st, knit next 28 sts, take off 23 sts on holder (2nd sleeve), cast on 2 st, knit 18 st to end.

Next row: Knit 4, purl to last 4 st, k 4.

Knit 1 row: Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 3 inches measured from the underarm, ending with a purl row.

Pattern: Attach green, k 5 white, *k 1 green, k 3 white* (repeat between stars) across, ending k 6 white.

Row 2: K 4 white, attach lt. pink and *p 1 lt. pink, p 3 white* to last 4 white.

Row 3: K 7 white, *k 1 lt. pink, k 3 white* ending 4 white.

Row 4: K 4 white, p 2 lt. pink, *p 1 white, p 3 lt. pink* to last 6 st, ending p 1 white, p 1 lt. pink, k 4 white.

Row 5: K 4 white, attach dk. pink, *k 3 lt. pink, k 1 dk. pink* to last 4 st, attach another ball of white, k 4 white.

Row 6: Same as Row 4.

Row 7: Same as Row 3.

Row 8: Same as Row 2.

Row 9: Same as Row 1. Detach and fasten off all colors except white.

Row 10: K 4 white, purl to last 4 st, k 4 white.

Row 11: Knit. Repeat these last 2 rows until piece measures 6 inches from underarm, ending with a knit row.

Work 5 rows of garter stitch (knit every row) and bind off very loosely.

Sleeves: With No. 10 needles, and 2 balls of white yarn, (both sleeves will be knit at the same time) take stitches off holders, and knit, increasing 1 st at beginning and end of each sleeve. Purl 1 row, knit 1 row, repeating last 2 rows until it measures 3 inches from underarm, ending with a knit row. Work 5 rows of garter stitch and bind off loosely, leaving 18 inch strand of yarn for sewing.

With yarn needle, sew seams to underarm (weaving in last sts at underarm), fasten securely. Block entire garment.

With crochet hook, make a chain about 2 inches long, thread it through the casing at the neck, then make lt. pink pom-poms and attach to ends of chain.

FAIR ISLE BABY BONNET

Materials: 2 oz. 4-ply Orlon yarn (main color), small amounts of three contrasting colors, (shown in white, light and dark pink, green), sizes 8 and 10 single-pointed knitting needles, tapestry-yarn needle, size E crochet hook, scissors.

With white yarn and No. 8 needles, cast on 9 sts.

Row 1: (Always repeat instructions between stars.) K 1, *yo, k 1* to end.

Row 2: (And all even rows), purl.

Row 3: K 1, *yo, k 2* to end.

Row 5: K 1, *yo, k 3* to end.

Row 7: K 1, *yo, k 4* to end.

Row 9: K 1, *yo, k 5* to end.

Row 11: K 1, *yo, k 6* to end.

Row 12: Change to No. 10 needles and knit 1 row (57 st).

Row 13: Knit.

Row 14: Purl.

Pattern: Attach green (do not cut white).

Row 1: *K 3 white, k 1 green* ending k 1 white. Attach lt. pink, cut green.

Row 2: *Purl 3 white, p 1 lt. pink* ending p 1 white.

Row 3: K 1 white, *k 1 lt. pink, k 3 white* to end.

Row 4: P 2 white, *p 3 lt. pink, p 1 white* ending p 3 lt. pink. Attach dk. pink.

Row 5: K 1 lt. pink, *k 1 dk. pink, k 3 lt. pink*, cut dark pink.

Row 6: (Cut white from other end, attach to this end.) Purl 2 white, *p 3 lt. pink, p 1 white* ending p 3 lt. pink.

Row 7: Repeat row 3.

Row 8: Repeat row 2, cut pink, attach green.

Row 9: Repeat row 1, cut green.

Row 10: Purl (white).

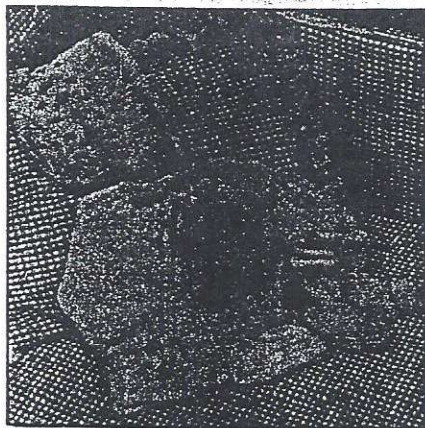
Cast off 3 st at beg of each of next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st at beg and end of each of next 2 knit rows. End with purl row, decreasing 1 st at end of this row (46 st). Change to No. 8 needles, and rib (k 1, p 1) for 2 rows. Attach lt. pink and continue in ribbing for 2 rows, then rib 2 rows of white. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

Finishing: Fasten all loose ends, and cut.

With yarn needle and white yarn, sew back seam starting at front edge of neck, and ending at back, run yarn through the 9 cast-on st and pull tight, fasten off.

Ties: With E crochet hook and white yarn make 2 chains about 14 inches long. Fasten 1 to each side of ribbing edge. With lt. pink yarn, make two small pom-poms and attach to ends of



FAIR ISLE BABY SACQUE

Materials: 4 oz. white 4-ply Orlon yarn, small amounts of light pink, dark pink and green 4-ply Orlon yarn, sizes 8 and 10 single pointed knitting needles, yarn needle, two stitch holders, C crochet hook, scissors.

Starting at the neck, with No. 8 needles, cast on 38 stitches with lt. pink yarn: Knit 1 row, attach white

Baby Layette Sweater

Materials: 1 4 oz. skein of knitted worsted
1 pair size 10½ knitting needles

Starting a neck edge, cast on 34 sts. Always K first and last 3 sts. for borders.

- Row 1 & 2: K.
Row 3: (Beading row) K 3 * p 2 tog., YO, repeat from * across, ending P 2 tog., K 3 (33 sts.)
Row 4: K.
Row 5: K 3, P across to last 3 sts. K 3.
Row 6: K 3, * K in front and back of next sts. (increase), K 1, repeat from * across, ending increase 1 st., K 3 (47).
Row 7: K 3, P across to last 3 sts., K 3.
Row 8: K 3, * K 2 tog., repeat from * across to last 4 sts., K 4.
Row 9: K 3, * K 1, insert needle under next horizontal loop of row below (between sts.) and K this st. repeat from * across, ending K 4. (47)
Row 10: K 3, *increase 1 in next st., K 2 and repeat from * across, ending increase 1 st., K 4.(61)
Row 11: Same as row 7.
Row 12: Same as row 8 (34)
Row 13: Same as row 9 (61)
Row 14: K 4, * increase 1 st. in next st., K 3, repeat from * across, ending with increase 1 st. K 4 (75)
Row 15: Same as row 7.
Row 16: Same as row 8.
Row 17: Same as row 9.
Row 18: K 4, * increase 1 st. in next st., K 4, repeat from * across, ending with increase 1 st., K 5. (89)
Row 19: Same as row 7.
Row 20: Same as row 8.
Row 21: Same as row 9.
Row 22: K 5, * increase 1 st. in next st. K 5, repeat from * across row. (103)
Row 23: Same as row 7.
Row 24: Same as row 8.
Row 25: Same as row 9.
Row 26: K 18 (front). Increase 1 st. in next st., place marker on needle, increase 1 st., K 14 (sleeve) increase 1 st. in next st., place marker on needle, increase 1 st. in next st. K 31 (back), increase 1 st. in next st., place marker on needle, increase 1 st. in next st. K 14 (sleeve), increase 1 st. in next st., place marker on needle, increase 1 st. in next st. K 18 (111)
Row 27: K 3, P across to last 3 sts., K 3.
Row 28: K increasing 1 st. each side of markers (119)
Row 29: Repeat last two rows one more time (127).
Row 30: K3, P across

Row 31 Divide sts. as follows: (right side) K 22 sts. of left front, slipping next 22 sts. onto st. holder (sleeve); K next 39 sts. (back), slip next 22 sts. onto st. holder (sleeve), K remaining 22 sts. (right front). Work in stockinette sts. 4 ½ inches from underarm, ending on wrong side. From here you can either work in ribbing of K1 P1, for 1 ½ inches and bind off OR match the yoke as follows: Work rows 8 & 9 of pattern st. in stockinette st. for 4 rows even, then work eyelet row for turn of hem as follows: K 3 * K 2 tog., YO, repeat from * a row ending YO, K 4. Work 4 rows in stockinette st. Bind off. Turn up the hem at lower edge and sew in place. Work sleeves in stockinette st. for 4 inches and ribbing of 1 ½ inches. Bind off. Sew sleeve seams. Crochet chain about 30 inches long and draw through.
