Such was the case with Power of Bold Day Social Action presenter, Lisa Eckerle Hankins, from United Way of N W Michigan. She informed us of the 211 help line; one number to call to locate all the social services of your county. That information has been given to all Northern Waters District churches via Randie Clawson's Peace and Justice newsletter as well as taken by attendees to their individual church home. Churches have also been informed of the County Collaboratives; social service agencies which meet to work cooperatively on common concerns. The word spreads and multiplies reaching more of our neighbors who need assistance.

Justice for Our Neighbors (JFON) recently held an informational evening at Petoskey UMC. JFON provides free and low cost legal services to low income immigrants. Their offices are located at Central UMC in Traverse City.

Some of us who attended that presentation also attended a presentation at Greensky Hill Indian UMC with the Rev. Paul Perez, Associate Coordinator for Mission

and Ministry, Michigan Conference. He presented information and a video of his trip to our Southern Border to observe and learn about immigrant issues.
